

Black Cumin: Health Benefits and Uses

Introduction:-

Black cumin (*Nigella sativa*) is an annual herb with an erect stem that belongs to *Ranunculaceae* family of flowering plants. Black cumin is native to western Asia and southern Europe, but now days it is being grown throughout the India. The seeds of black cumin and its oil have been used for decades to cure various ailments throughout the world. Black cumin is an important drug in Indian traditional medicine system like Unani and Ayurveda. Also its seeds have been used as a condiment too.

Botanical Description:-

A glabrous annual herb grows to height of about 1-2 feet. Leaves are alternate, feathery, finely divided, greyish green in color. Flowers are star shaped and bluish-white in color. Petals are absent. The fruit is globose capsule with small trigonous black seeds.

Method of Propagation:-

Black cumin is propagated either by sowing seeds or by replanting previous year root stocks (bulbs). Seed sowing is done during October-November by broadcasting and line sowing methods. Bulb sowing is possible when moisture content of soil is adequate for deep ploughing i.e. neither too dry nor too wet.

Chemical constitution:-

Black cumin seeds contain

- **1.** Fixed oil 32 to 40% (palmitic acid, stearic acid, arachidonic, linoleic and oleic acid)
- 2. Volatile oil -0.45 to 0.45% (thymoquinone, nigellone, thymol, thymohydroquinine)
- **3.** Minerals 1.79-3.74% (potassium, sodium, calcium, iron, phosphorus)
- **4.** Proteins 16-19.9% (leucine, lysine, tyrosine, proline, glutamic acid)



- **5.** Carbohydrates 33.9%
- **6.** Fibers 5.50%
- 7. Water 6.0%

Health benefits:-

Black cumin (*N. sativa*) is widely used medicinal plant throughout the world and considered as a miracle herb because of its wide spectrum therapeutic properties, some of its properties are listed below:-

- Black cumin and its compounds are widely known for their potent anti-cancer effect.
- Reduces blood sugar level.
- Have Hepatoprotective properties
- Black cumin seeds are effective against cough, bronchitis, chest congestion, back pain, rheumatism, chronic headache, migraine, paralysis, obesity, flatulence, dysentery and diarrhea.
- Black cumin seeds oils is used to treat allergic diseases.
- Have a normalizing effect on hypertension.
- Provides protection against Parkinson's disease.
- Black cumin seeds have been shown to especially effective at lowering cholesterol.
- Black cumin seeds have significant positive effect on bone healing and formation because it boosts the process of osteogenesis, increase bone density and calcium concentration.
- Helps to control anxiety and depression.
- Black cumin seeds have shown therapeutic promise against wide range of kidney diseases.

Beside all of these therapeutic effects black cumin seeds also contains high amount of anti-oxidants, which helps in neutralizing harmful free radicals that may lead to development of various diseases.
