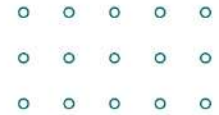

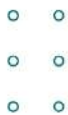


About The CONFERENCE

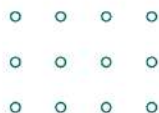

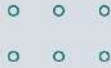

PRESENTATIONS DURING GIRDAHA-2023

Lead Paper Presentations

The presentation under this category would offer an insight into the various themes of the conference. A Technical Committee will identify 2 - 3 speakers in each theme. Each lecture will be of 15-20 minutes followed by discussion. Lead speakers of the conference will be requested to provide 3-4 pages extended summaries of their presentation for inclusion in the Conference proceedings.

Abstract

The abstract should be in English using MS word (Single space; Font Cambria; Font size- 12) and should not exceed 350 words. The abstracts must contain title of the paper, name(s) of author(s) followed by their affiliation and e-mail. The name of presenting author should be underlined. Submit your abstracts at abstract.aeefws@gmail.com

Oral Papers:

Among the accepted abstracts, 7-10 selected papers will be considered for oral presentations under each of the technical sessions. Each oral presentation would be allotted 8- 10 minutes. Power Point Presentation with not more than 15 slides of the same are required to be handed over to the conveners of the respective sessions.

Poster Presentation

Separate Poster Sessions covering all the themes will be organized to encourage wider interaction and information sharing. There will be Hybrid Mode for Poster Presentation. The extended summary contributed for presentation will be screened as per the theme. Each poster session will have Chairman and Co-Chairman. They will prepare and present summary of the concerned Poster Session for formulation of meaningful recommendations. All the participants are requested to prepare their posters that should not exceed the dimensions of 25" x 40" 1.0 x 1.5 m (length x width), Font Size: Title- 86pt, Authors-50pt, Sub heading-36pt, Text-24 pt, Caption-18pt and Poster must include the title, Authors Name, Affiliation, Introduction, Material and Methods, Results and Discussion and Conclusion. Clear pictures, diagrams, graphs and short tables are highly encouraged to use.

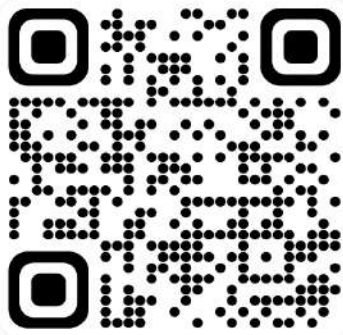

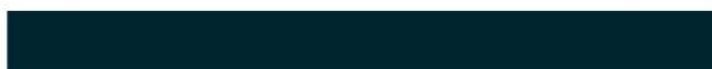

ABOUT Madhya Pradesh



Deogarh Fort, Chhindwara

Landlocked in the central part of the country, Madhya Pradesh is bordered by the states of Rajasthan to its northwest, Uttar Pradesh to its north, Chhattisgarh to its east, Maharashtra to its south, and Gujarat to its west. Madhya Pradesh had the honour of being the largest state of the country until Chhattisgarh was carved out of it on November 1, 2000.

Madhya Pradesh has a mixed topography that consists of both hills and plains. The state has three predominant seasons: winter (November to February), summer (March to May), and the monsoon season (June to September). During the winter, average temperatures range from 10° to 27° C (50° to 81° F). Summers are hot, with an average temperature of 29° C (85° F) and a high temperature that at times reaches 48° C (118° F). During the monsoon season average temperature lies between average 19° to 30° C (66° to 86°). Madhya Pradesh receives an average annual rainfall of about 1200 mm (nearly 50 inches), of which 90 percent falls during the monsoon season.
